Visit of Prof. William Nganje from NDSU, USA.



Dr. William Nganje, Professor and Chair, Agribusiness and Applied Economics, North Dakota State University, USA, visited MPBIM campus on 2nd Sep 2024. He discussed and deliberated with faculty and management regarding high-quality research papers and potential future collaborations. He also presided over the release of the DHARANA-International Journal of Business, Vol.15 Iss #1. The release event was attended by **Er. N. Ramanuja, Chairman, V. Muralidhar, Vice Chairman, Mr. Sanjib Jha** from NITTE School of Management, and **Dr. S.Sathyannarayana**, Principal MPBIM. Professor Nganje explored avenues for collaboration between MPBIM faculty and students and NDSU, emphasizing the advantages of joint research initiatives in enhancing academic excellence. He also discussed the financial challenges associated with accessing extensive databases like Bloomberg, highlighting the substantial investment needed for cutting-edge research in fields such as finance, agribusiness, and commodity markets.

Dr.Nganje conducted a session for final semester students on commodity derivatives, focusing on Value at Risk(VaR) and Risk Management Strategies. He also delved into the impact of U.S. elections on global markets and the challenges faced by agro-intensive economies like India. Dr.Nganje underscored the interconnected nature of global markets and made remarks about how India can strengthen its economic fundamentals, diversify its portfolio, and capitalize on its agricultural potential through technological advancements, supply chain enhancements, and expansion into new markets. Students were encouraged to strategize leveraging India's agricultural strengths and explore opportunities in various sectors for economic resilience. The session concluded with Dr.Nganje applauding students for their insightful inquiries and encouraged the students to delve deeper into latest challenges to prepare for future leadership roles.



Principal speaks...The Role of Critical Thinking and Research in Postgraduate Teaching

In today's rapidly evolving academic and professional landscape, postgraduate education demands more than mere transfer of knowledge; it requires the cultivation of critical thinking and research skills. These competencies are essential for fostering intellectual independence, innovative problem-solving, and the ability to adapt to new challenges. Critical thinking and research are not just academic tools; they are fundamental components of postgraduate education that shape students into thought leaders and innovators in their respective fields. At the postgraduate level, critical thinking transcends the traditional approach of absorbing information. It involves analyzing, evaluating, and synthesizing knowledge to develop well-informed perspectives and solutions to complex problems. Students must learn to question assumptions, assess the credibility of sources, and draw logical conclusions based on evidence. This intellectual rigor not only strengthens their academic performance but also prepares them for the complexities of real-world decision-making. In a world saturated with information, critical thinking is crucial for distinguishing between credible research and misinformation. This process enhances their analytical abilities, enabling them to critique existing theories and propose innovative solutions that drive progress in their fields.

Unlike undergraduate education, where students primarily learn established theories and concepts, postgraduate programs emphasize the creation of new knowledge through research. This requires students to identify research gaps, formulate relevant questions, and employ appropriate methodologies to address them. Engaging in research nurtures intellectual curiosity and encourages students to explore uncharted territories. It provides them with the tools to systematically investigate phenomena, test hypotheses, and generate findings that can in-

fluence academic discourse and practical applications. Critical thinking and research are deeply intertwined, each reinforcing the other. It sharpens students' research abilities by helping them design robust studies, interpret data accurately, and avoid cognitive biases. Conversely, research activities enhance critical thinking by encouraging students to confront ambiguity, solve complex problems, and refine their arguments based on empirical evidence. For example, when postgraduate students engage in research, they are often required to critically evaluate existing literature. This process demands that they question the validity of previous studies, identify inconsistencies, and propose new approaches. At the same time, conducting research forces students to think critically about their own findings, ensuring that their conclusions are grounded in logic and supported by evidence. Educators should foster an environment that encourages inquiry, debate, and experimentation. Assignments should be designed to promote deep engagement with material, encouraging students to question, critique, and propose alternatives. Moreover, postgraduate programs should integrate research opportunities early in the curriculum, enabling students to apply critical thinking in real-world contexts.

Critical thinking and research are indispensable elements of postgraduate education. Together, they equip students with the intellectual tools necessary to navigate the complexities of their disciplines and contribute meaningfully to their fields. 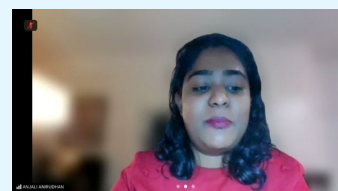
Alumni Talk Series 2024

Webinar Series 2024: Webinar 1 on Unlocking Insights into the Practicality of Business Analytics



MPBIM launched its **Webinar Series 2024** with the first session titled "**Unlocking Insights into the Practicality of Business Analytics**," held on Saturday, July 20, 2024. The webinar featured **Mr. M.K. Singh**, a practicing Business Analyst and Director at IBM Kyndryl, along with **Dr. R. Deepak**, Head of the Department of Management Studies at Ramaiah Institute of Technology, as the presenters. The session began with opening remarks from **Chairman Er. N. Ramanuja**, followed by insights from Principal **Dr. Satyanarayana** on the webinar series. Setting the stage for the first presentation.

Mr. Singh explored the essential components of customer analytics, emphasizing the importance of gathering, analyzing, and interpreting customer data to gain insights that enhance customer relationships and improve data visualization using Microsoft Power BI. His discussion covered various aspects of customer analytics, including target audience identification, customer acquisition, retention, satisfaction, and segmentation. He provided a thorough explanation of how these factors are measured and scored, their impact on the sales funnel, and the differences between traditional and predictive lead scoring. Participants particularly appreciated his insights on leveraging data to inform product development and prioritize product safety features.

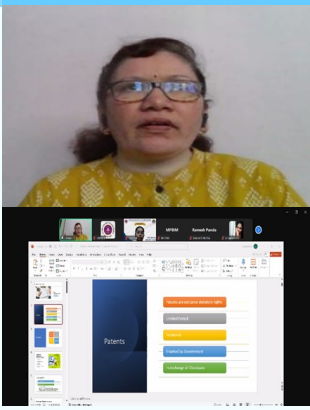
Dr. Deepak showcased, using live data, how business analytics provides timely decision support. He emphasized that collecting, integrating, and storing data for analysis are critical components of business analytics. One of the primary challenges users face with analytical tools is efficiently retrieving and disseminating information to facilitate informed decision-making. Through various case studies, he illustrated how business analytics (BA) enhances competitiveness, streamlines operational processes, and supports strategic decision-making within organizations. Looking to the future, Dr. Deepak advised students to train in tools like SPSS, R, Python, JMP, and Microsoft Excel, urging them to equip themselves with analytical skills relevant to specialized fields. The Webinar was coordinated by **Dr Hema Harsha** and **Dr Pushpa B V** and had 135 participants from India and overseas as well.

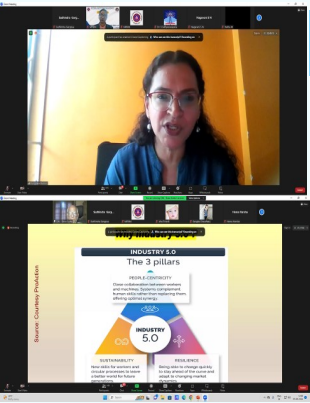
Webinar 2 on Academic patents : With Special reference to Management Research



On July 27, 2024, the second webinar on **Academic Patents with Special Reference to Management Research** was held, featuring speakers **Ms. Deepa ES**, Chief Technical Officer of Origin IP Solution, LLP, and **Dr. Ramesh Chandra Panda**, who holds the highest number of academic patents.

Ms. Deepa discussed the definition of a patent, the necessity of patenting, the patent application process, and the government bodies involved in granting patents for products and processes. She explored the intricacies of patenting in corporate settings versus individual protection, particularly regarding innovation ownership. Ms. Deepa emphasized the importance of novelty, utility, and non-obviousness (NUN) for securing a patent and addressed various challenges participants face during the patenting process.

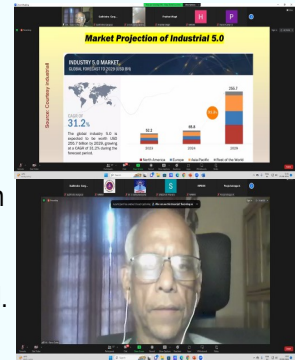
Dr. Ramesh Chandra, a leading figure behind 2,600 national and international patent grants, spoke about the types of patents available in management, focusing on utilities and work-related activities. He noted the rising number of patent grants, particularly in themes related to artificial intelligence. He encouraged attendees to concentrate on pressing issues to identify potential solutions that could lead to new concepts and innovations. Additionally, he highlighted recent patent trends in areas such as help desk devices and kiosks. The webinar attracted 77 participants from India and abroad and the event was coordinated by **Dr. Sumitra Sreenath**.



The Third webinar in the series was on **Preparing Leaders for Industry 5.0** and was held on 3rd Aug 2024 featuring **Dr. Sangeeta Mansur**, Sustainability & Integration Catalyst and Founder, Bhairavi Business & Consultancy and **Mr. Basu Dutta**, Management Consultant and Leadership Competency Assessor

Dr. Sangeeta Mansur emphasized the connection between Industry 5.0 and Sustainable Development Goals, focusing on sustainability and the optimal use of the planet's natural resources. She introduced the concept of "Sustainability Leadership," highlighting the importance of a forward-thinking vision, collaborative efforts, and adaptability as essential traits of effective leadership. Dr. Mansur explained how sustainable leadership equips organizations to navigate evolving risks and opportunities associated with sustainability, thereby ensuring resilience and ongoing growth.

Mr. Basu Dutta discussed the transition challenges of Industry 5.0 from a leadership perspective, emphasizing the significant shift in industrial growth. He noted that the market is projected to reach \$255 billion by 2029, with a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 31.2%. He focused on critical aspects such as human-machine collaboration, skill development, cultural change management, and the philosophy of change management as essential tools for effective leadership. By proactively addressing these challenges, leaders can successfully navigate the complexities of transitioning to Industry 5.0 and fully leverage its potential for organizational success, he said. The event was coordinated by **Prof Anu Natraj** and **Dr Hema Harsha**



Webinar 4 on Artificial Intelligence and Building Champion Teams

Ms. Binu Mathew, Head of Human Resources HP Inc., India spoke on **Artificial Intelligence and the HP AI PC: Building Champion Teams** on August 10th, 2024. Ms. Binu Mathews provided an insightful overview of Artificial Intelligence (AI), which simulates human intelligence in machines capable of thinking, learning, and problem-solving. AI systems can be programmed to carry out various tasks that typically require human intellect and involve repetitive actions, such as decision-making, language comprehension,

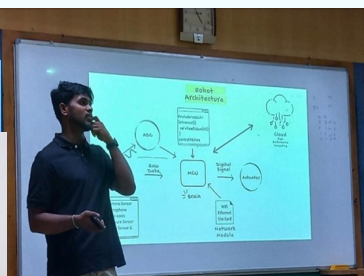
and visual perception. In her presentation, Ms. Mathews discussed the role of AI across different sectors, including Healthcare, Finance, Fraud Detection, Algorithmic Trading, Risk Management, and Customer Service Automation. She illustrated how AI-driven tools in education enhance personalized learning, automate grading, and offer virtual tutoring. Additionally, AI plays a crucial role in autonomous vehicles, traffic management systems, and route optimization, as well as in public service automation and smart city initiatives, contributing to policy-making insights. Ms. Mathews also touched on key AI components such as Machine Learning (ML), Natural Language Processing (NLP), Neural Networks, and Computer Vision that facilitate intelligent decision-making. The webinar was coordinated by **Prof Vijayalakshmi**.



Expert Talk—Integration of IoT (Internet of Things) and Cloud Computing

Mr. Dinesh Elumalai, a hardware engineer at **Sentinez Solutions**, discussed the integration of IoT (Internet of Things) and Cloud computing, which is transforming industrial automation and robotics. The session took place on August 13, 2024. By linking devices and sensors through IoT architecture, data can be collected, processed, and analyzed in real-time, improving the control systems of industrial robots. He highlighted how a data-driven approach is supported by modern programming languages that ensure smooth communication between IoT devices and cloud platforms. As part of the ongoing Industry 4.0

revolution, projects centered on robotics and IoT are expanding the possibilities in manufacturing and other industrial sectors. He deliberated on how these initiatives often seek innovative ways to utilize cloud computing for scalable, on-demand resources that enhance the capabilities of robotic systems, resulting in more efficient and adaptable production processes.
